


LOOK AROUND THE HOUSE TO FIND AND COLOR THE FOLLOWING LOST ITEMS:

Grab a couple of friends, write your own songs, make some instruments, rehearse and then grab your family to become your audience.


CHOOSE A NAME FOR YOUR BAND and write the name on the line below. (You can be a group or just a solo performer.)

MAKE A DRUM AND A KAZOO TO PLAY

DRUM:

Supplies Needed:

Coffee can with both ends removed (Round Oatmeal Box could also be used) Construction Paper Strapping or Packing Tape Glue Stick Markers




Directions:

- Remove both ends of Coffee Can.
- Use the tape (GRAY in picture right) to make a drumhead by covering one end of the can. Be sure to wrap tape very tight.
- 3. Glue construction paper around sides of can.
- 4. Decorate the construction paper using markers.

KAZOO:

Supplies Needed:

Empty Toilet Paper Roll Rubber Band
Construction Paper Markers
Glue Stick Wax Paper



Directions:

- 1. Peel all the paper off of the toilet paper roll.
- 2. Decorate the toilet paper roll with markers (or cut a piece of construction paper the size of the roll, decorate the paper, then glue it onto the roll).
- 3. Cut a piece of wax paper measuring 5 ½ inches by 5 ½ inches.
- 4. Place the wax paper (GRAY in picture above) covering one end of the roll and secure it with the rubber band (BLACK in picture above). Make sure it is on TIGHT!
- 5. Put your lips in the open end, say "AHHHH" to the tune of "Row, Row, Row Your Boat" and hear the tune.



WRITE A SONG

Try singing these new lyrics to the tune of Row, Row, Row Your Boat.

Let's play in the snow. Go and get a sled. We'll play until we're tired and Then we'll go to bed.

Now write your own song! Take a song you already know, like ROW, ROW, ROW YOUR BOAT, and re-write the lyrics (or words). Start by thinking of a topic you want to sing about (dog, school, mom, little brother, a rainy day). Write down your first line (that fits in with the number of syllables in "Row, row, row your boat"). Write the second line, making sure to have a word that is easy to rhyme as the last word. Write the third line. Write the fourth line, making sure the last word rhymes with the last word of the second line. Sing your new song! Use the drum and the Kazoo! Follow the directions above and write your new lyrics on lines below. Row, row, row your boat Gently down the stream. Merrily, merrily, merrily, merrily,

Life is but a dream.

Sing your new song. Add a Drum or Kazoo!
